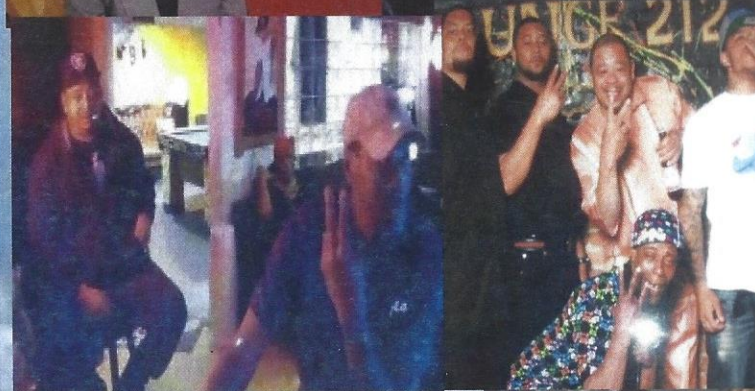


Lasting Memories
