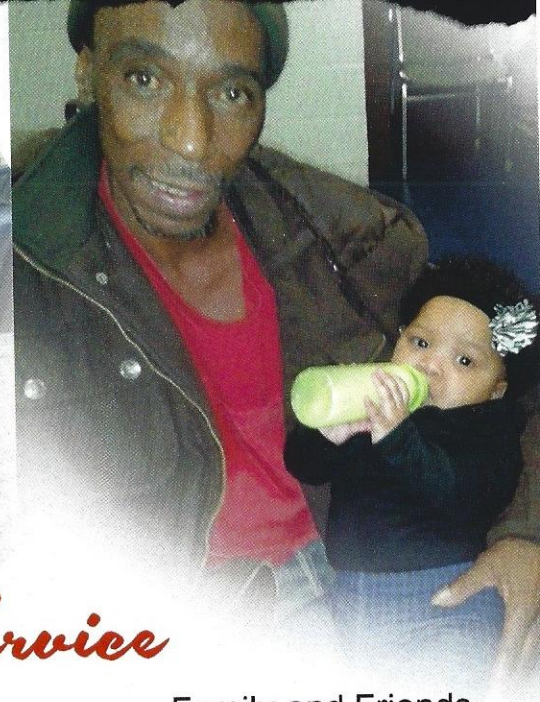
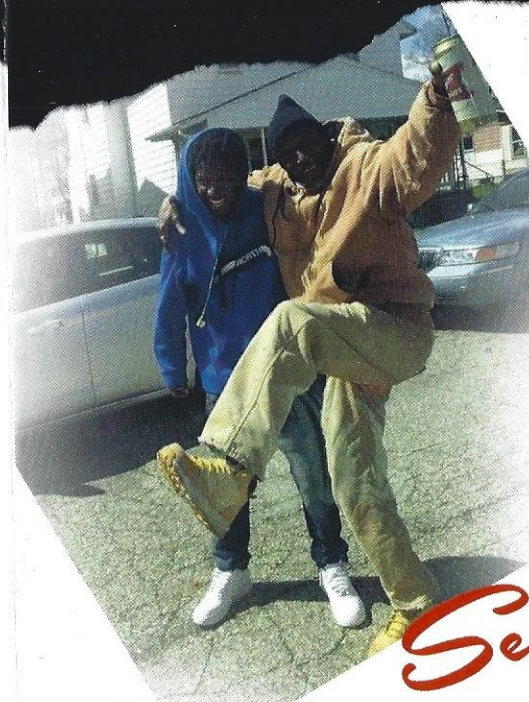
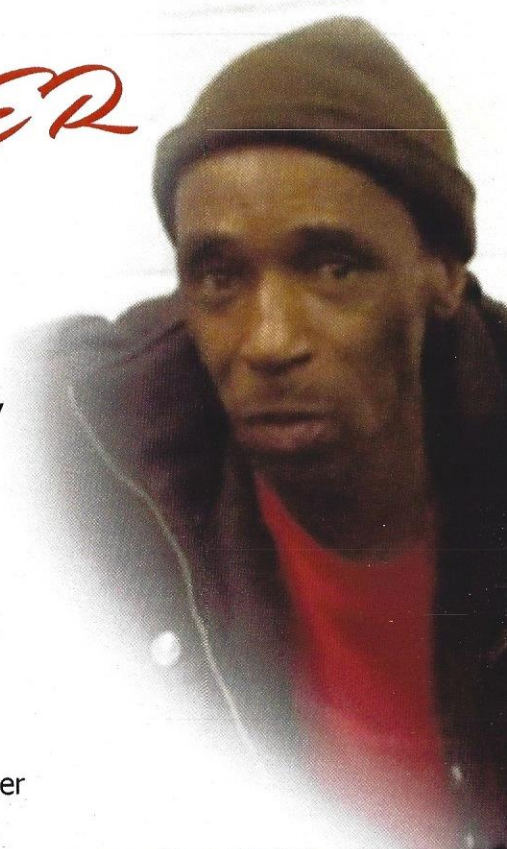
Curtis Simon
