I know you'll miss me too.

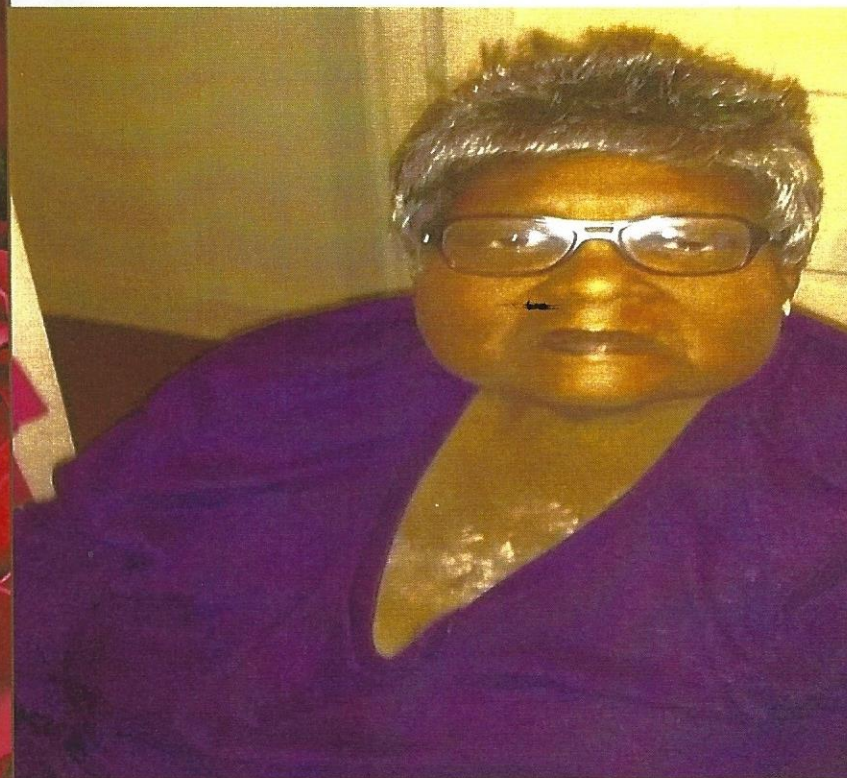
When tomorrow starts without me,

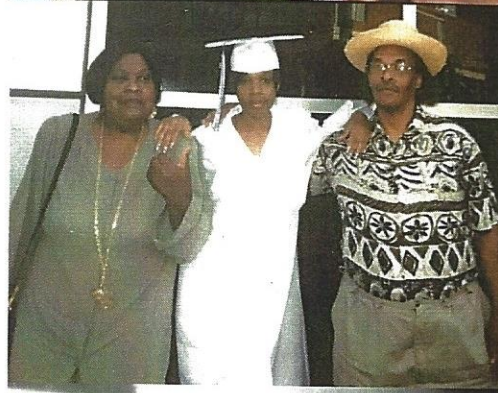

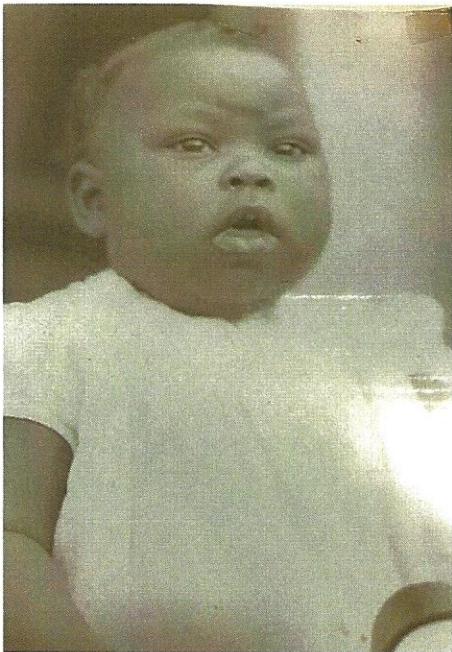
