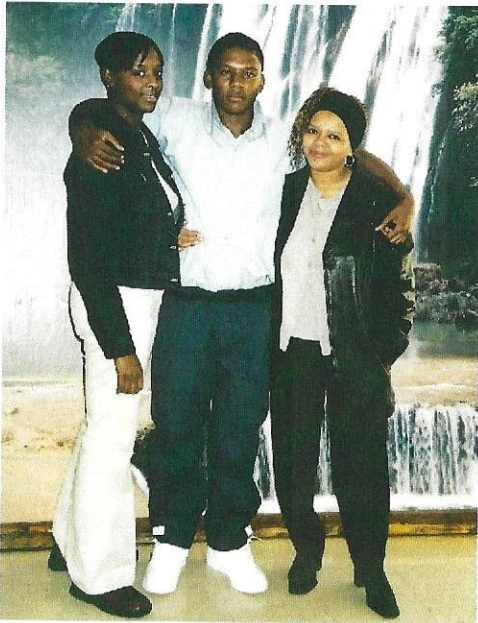


Time Will Ease The Hurt

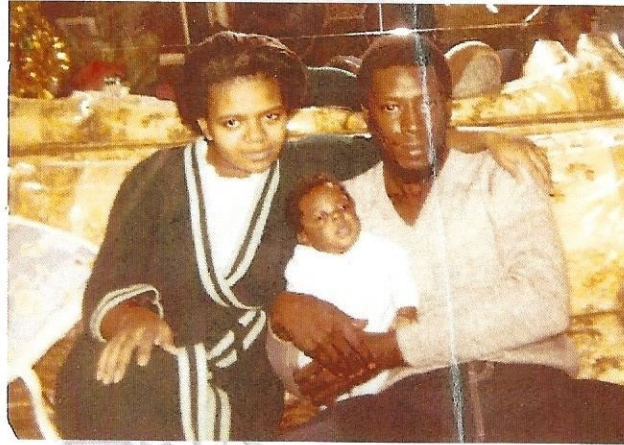

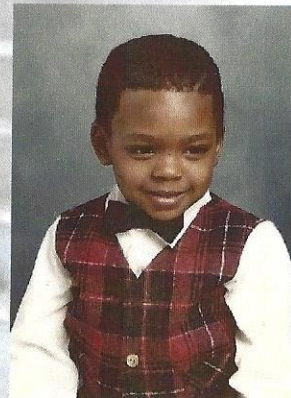

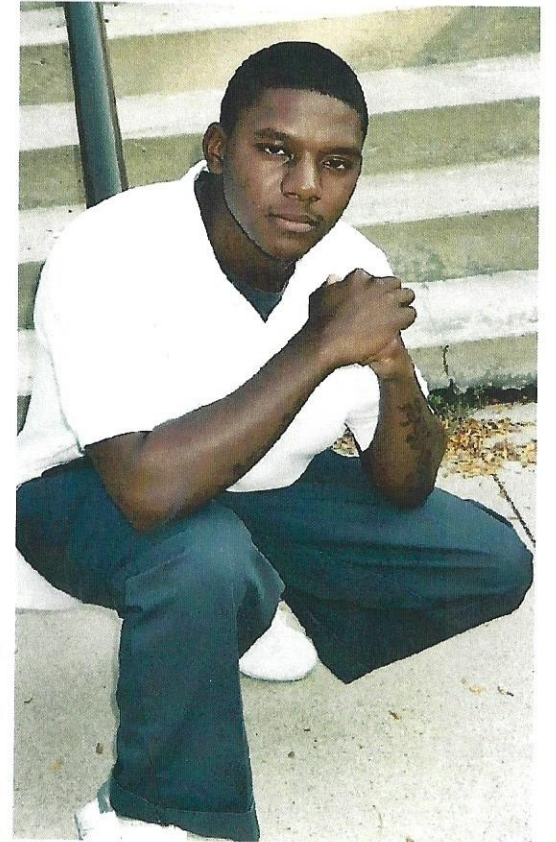
