No cry, no fight no-more

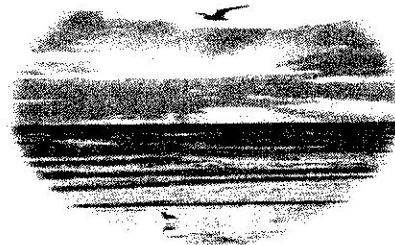
You can just soar and our memories of you will be something like a gentle breeze on a summer day.
