For several years she commuted to Los Angeles every 4 weeks working with aircraft manufacturers. She traveled to Switzerland to work with Swiss government on an agreement between the U.S. and the Swiss Government for aircraft purchases. Later she was tasked with the job of finding minority businesses to contract with the U.S. Government. She received recognition for her efforts along with the James Cisco Award for Superior Management of the Small Business Minority Enterprise Program at ASD WPAFB. As a member of Corinthian Baptist Church, Gaynelle served on many committees and taught Sunday School. She was active on the Nurses Guild. A lover of sports, particularly golf and was a member of the Fairway Golf Club and the Wright-Patt League until her health prevented her from playing. She was a Golden Life member of Delta Sigma Theta, Inc. and Past President of Dayton Alumnae Chapter. Also she was a member of Deborah Chapter #19 of the Ohio Eastern Star PHA. Gaynelle transitioned from this life on Thursday. November 12, 2020. Preceded in death by; daughter, Lorraine Christian.
