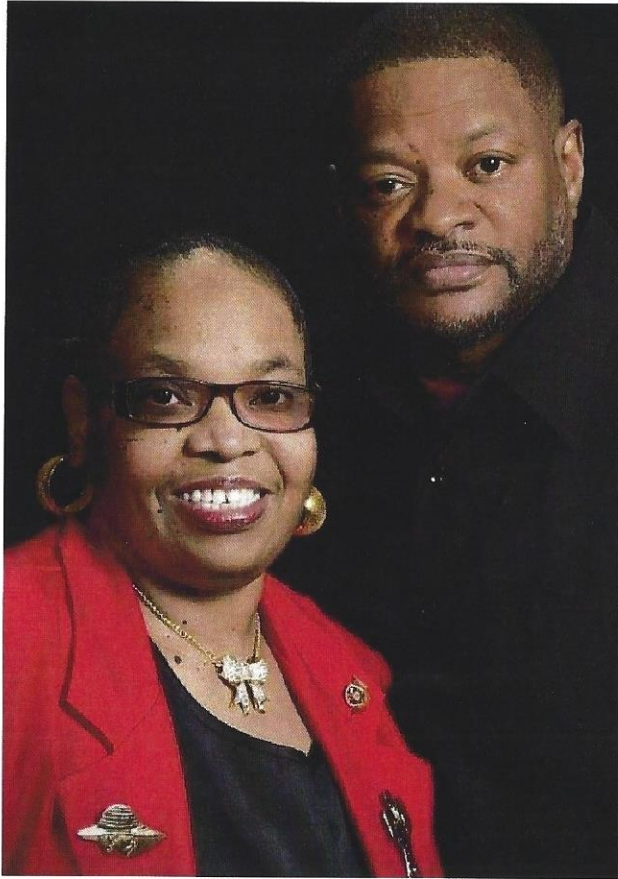


Sketch of Life

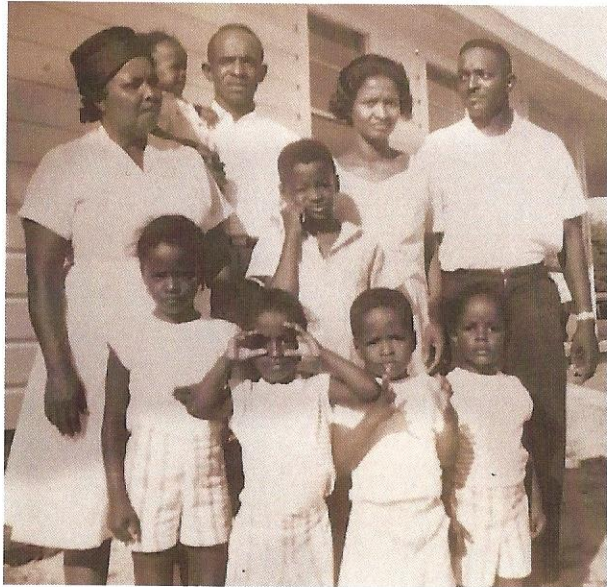
