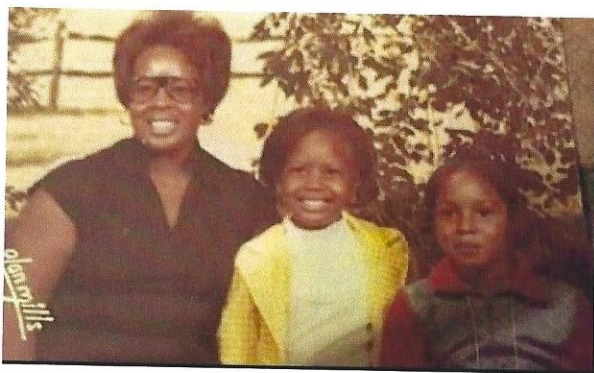


Don't Cry For Me

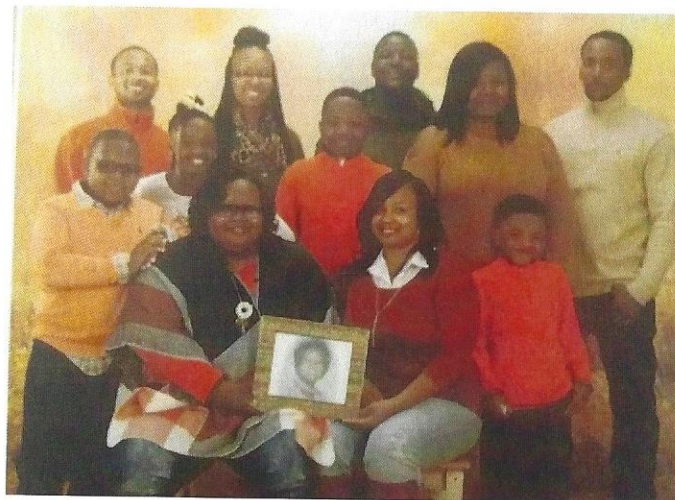

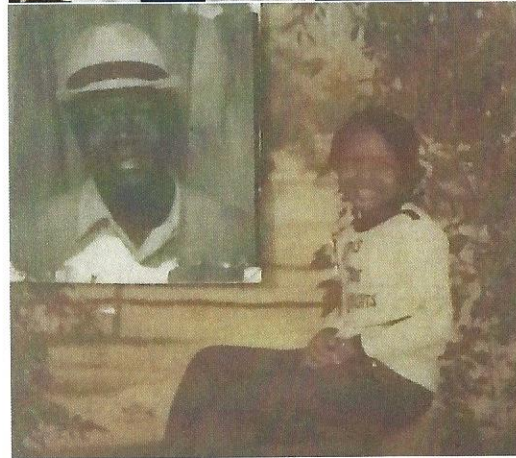

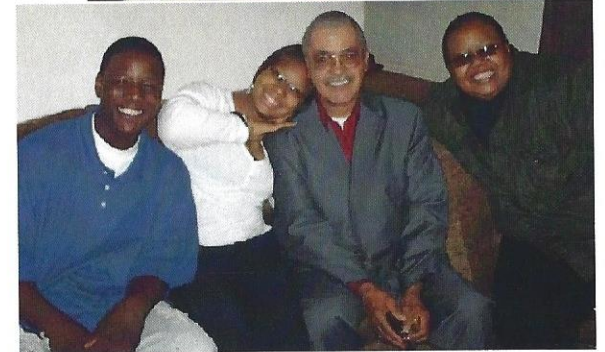
