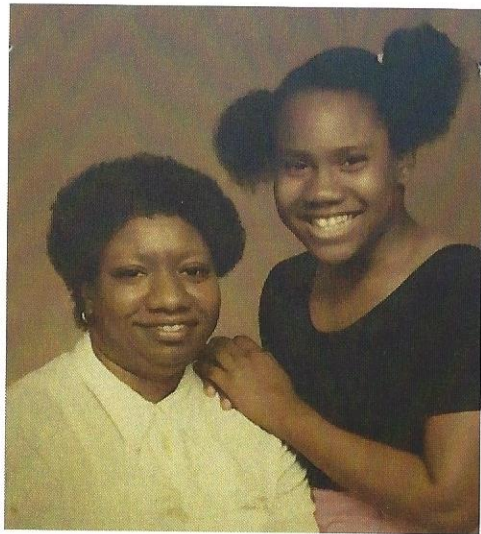


*When Tomorrow Starts

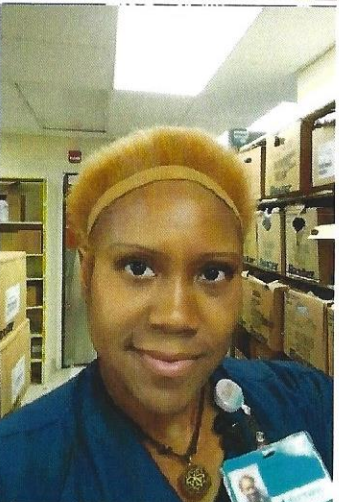
