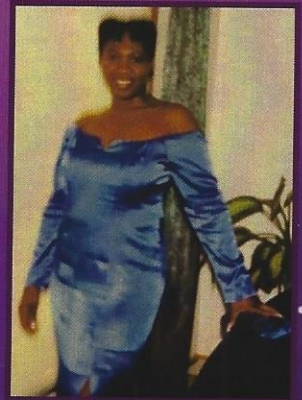

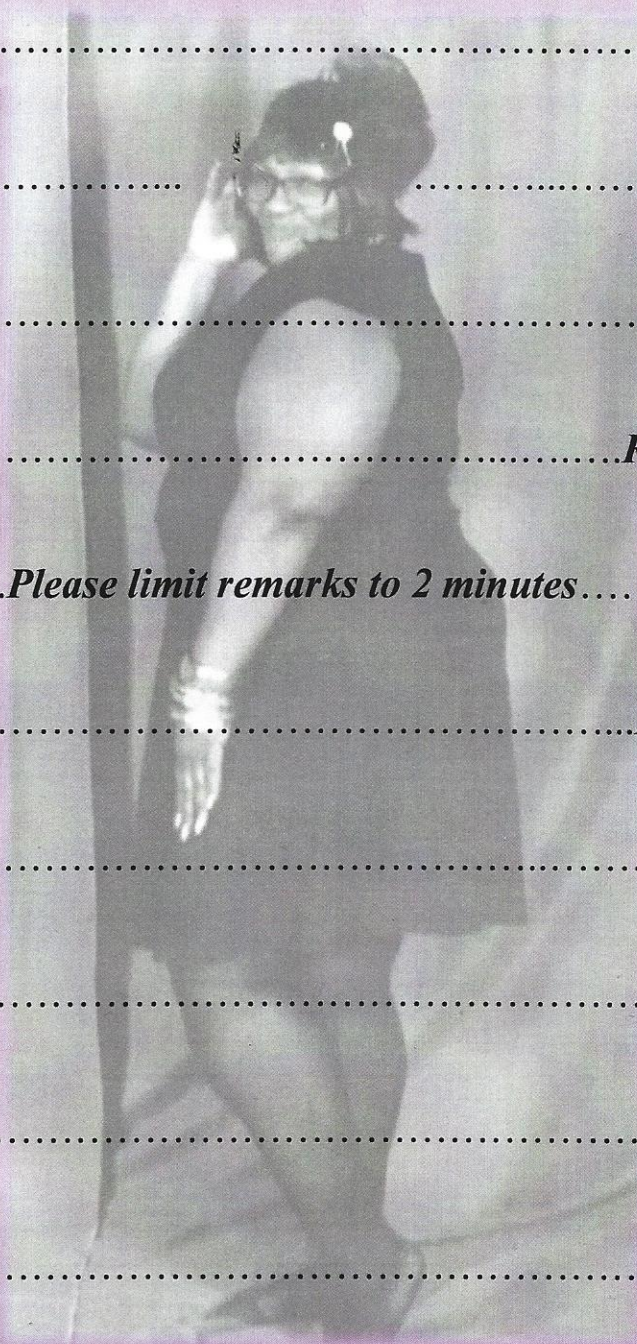
Tondra loved being around her family. Her joys were, singing, dancing and cooking. She once said that her only regret would be not being able to eat all of the good food that would be at her repast.

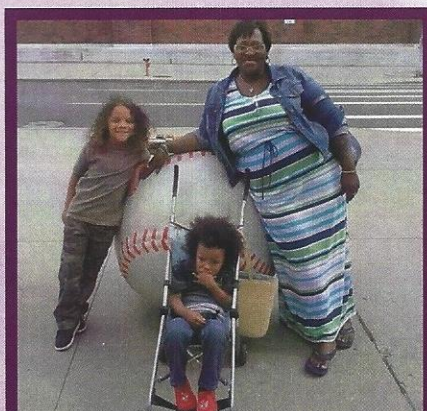
From my Heart to yours Cousin ♥

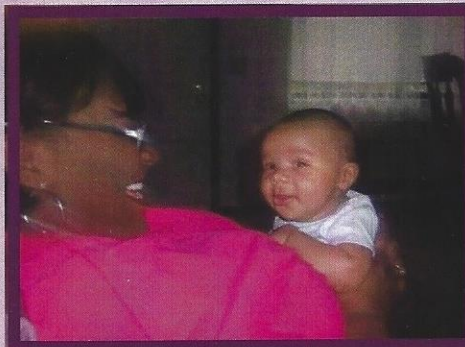

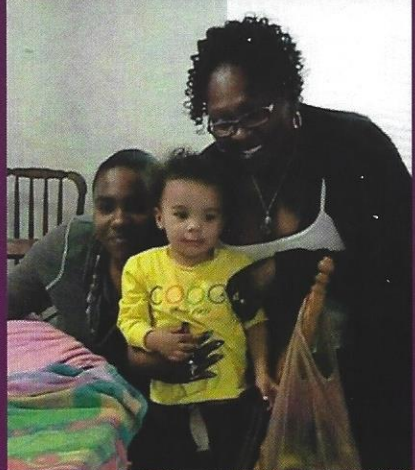

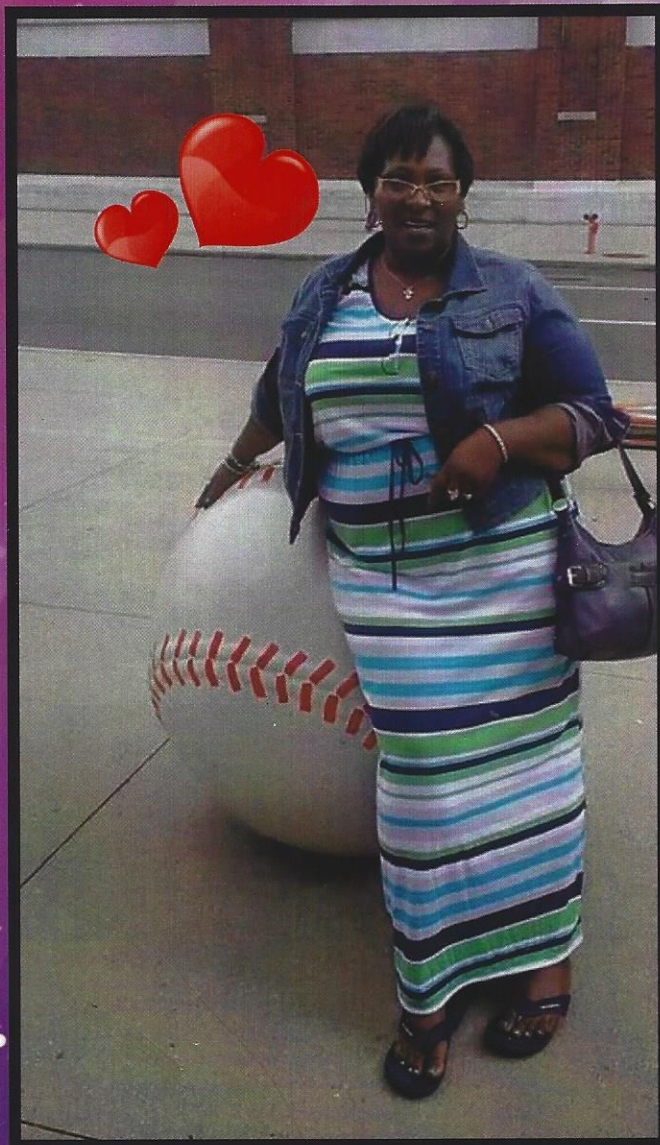
