

Afterglow

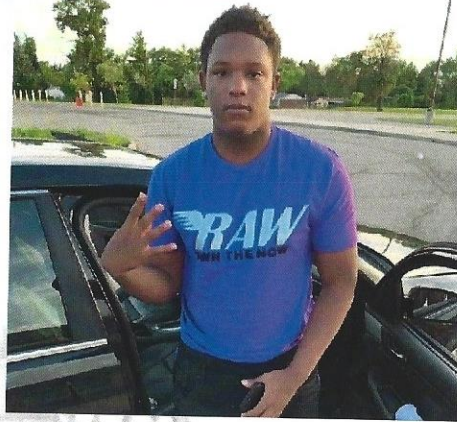
