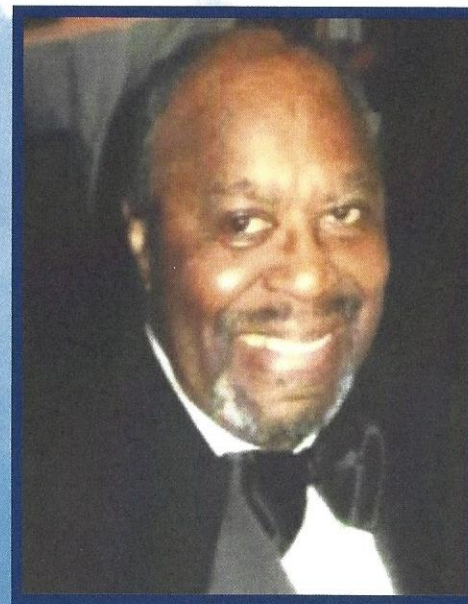

## Obituary

When his father retired from his own Lawn Care Business, He continued performing his services until his health began to fail.

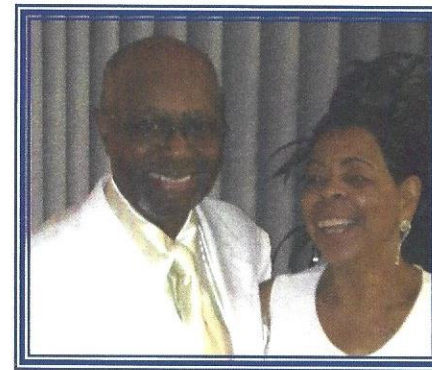
