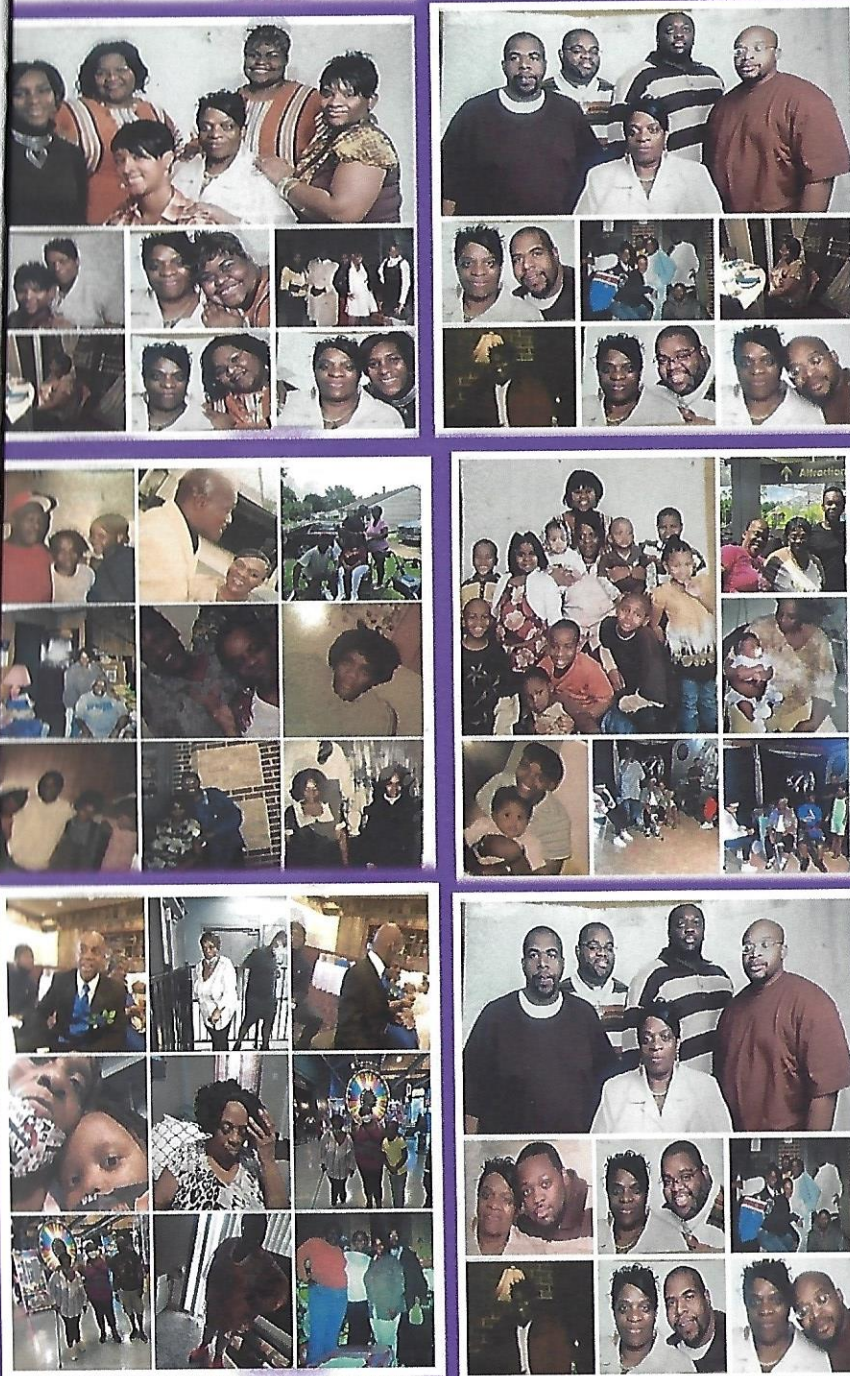
In our hearts you hold a place, no one else

you, the day God took you home.

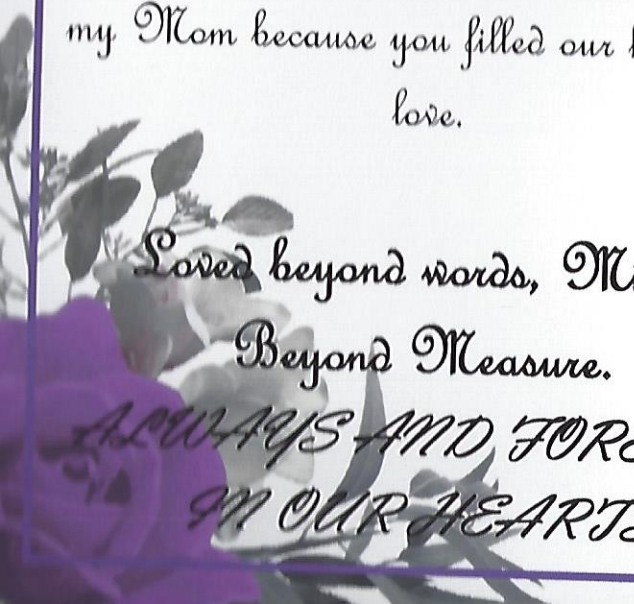
We will meet again one day I know up in
