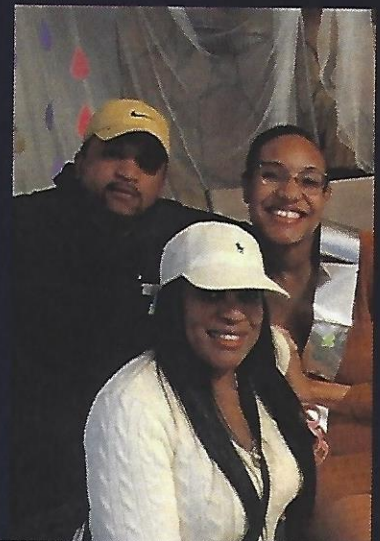
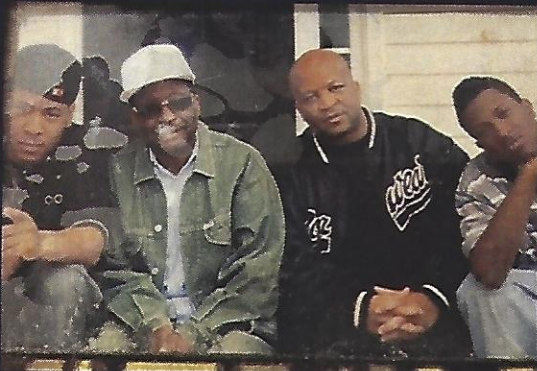
Athey was an extremely hardworking man. He worked for John R. Jurgenson for many years as a heavy highway construction worker, until his retirement in 2001.

Athey was an amazing man whose life was centered around his family. He was a devoted husband and loving father of six. His family brought joy and delight to his life.

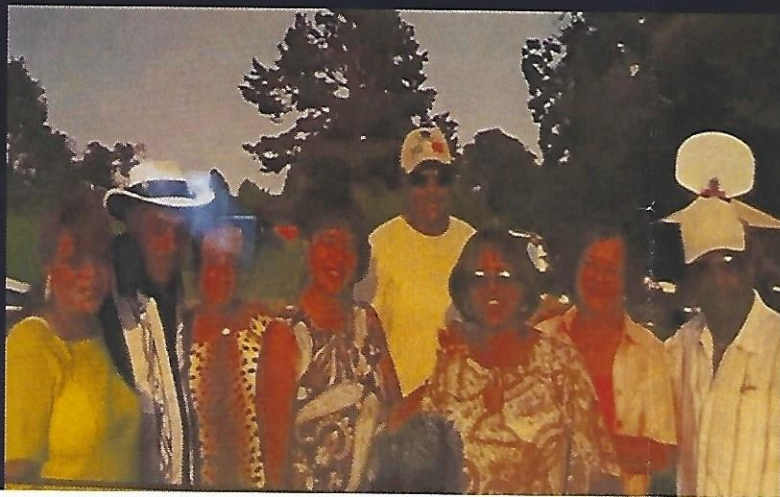
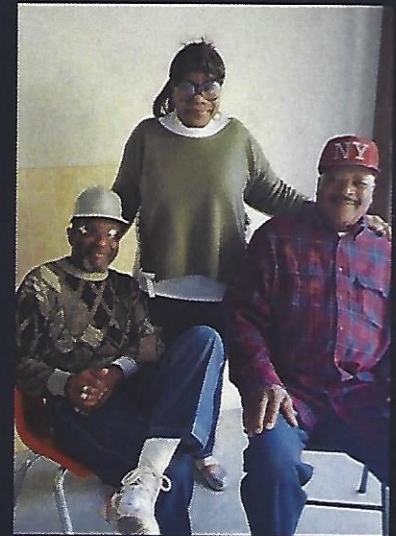
He loved to dance, and to be the life of every party. He had a signature dance that he would do at any party. Athey had a one-of-a-kind laugh and to know him, was to love him.
