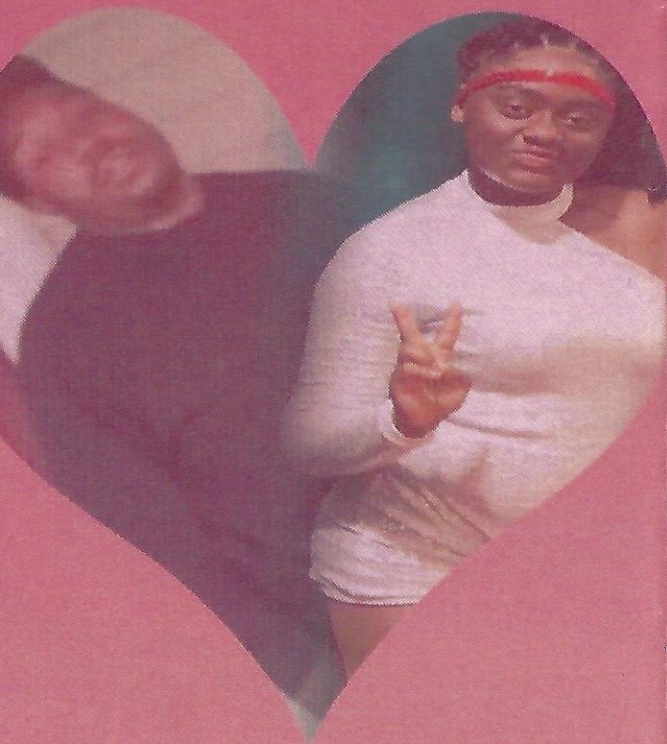


I Love You
