

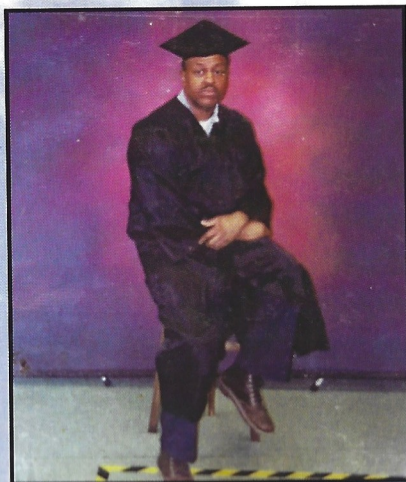
# *Life is but a stopping place*

to sweet eternity.*

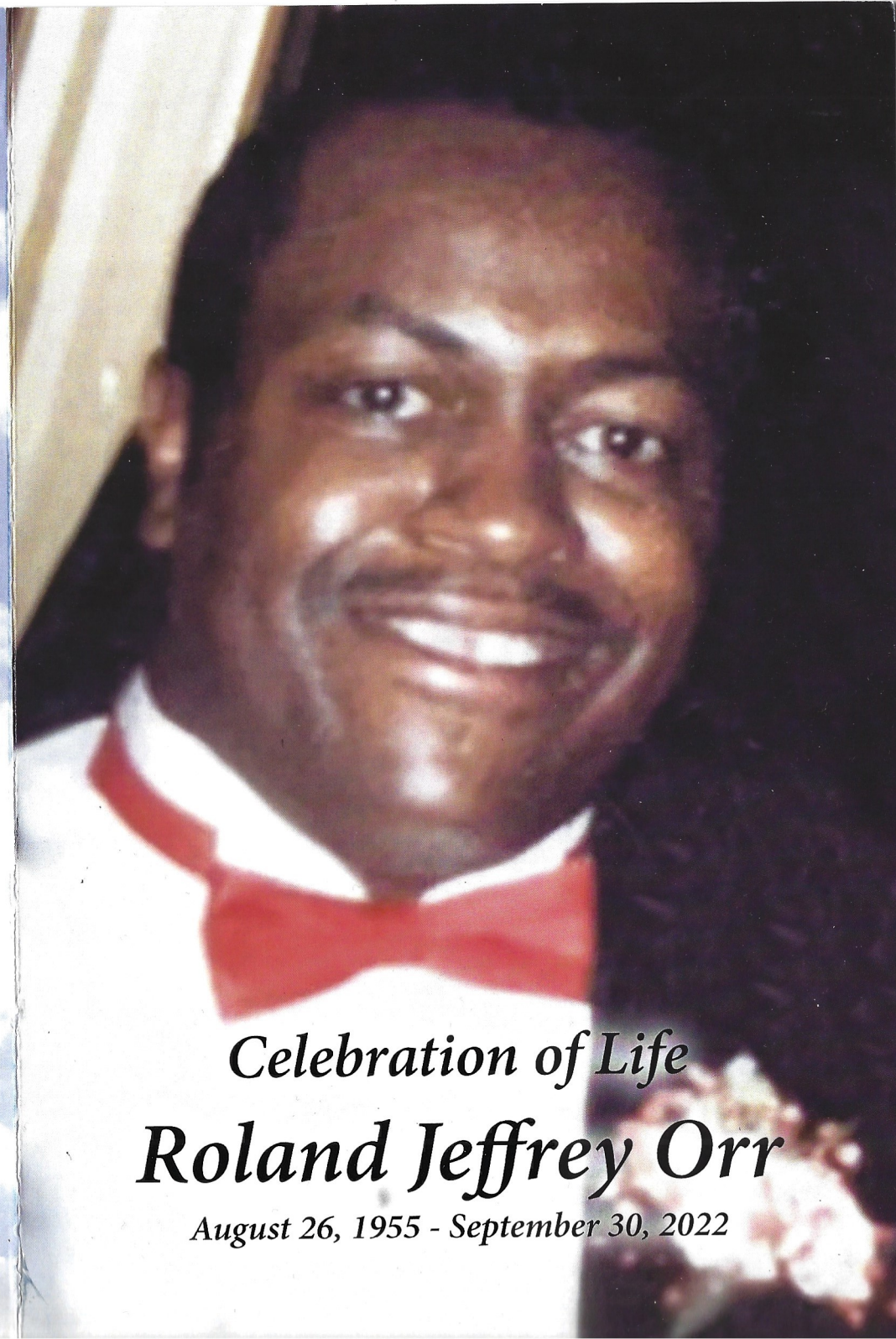
*We all have different journeys.
