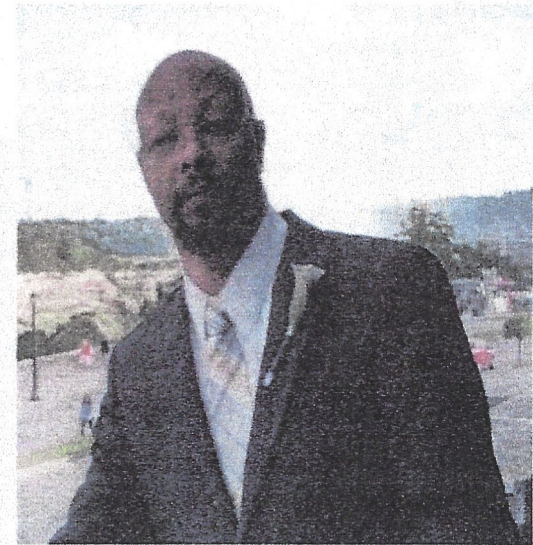


Special Thanks
