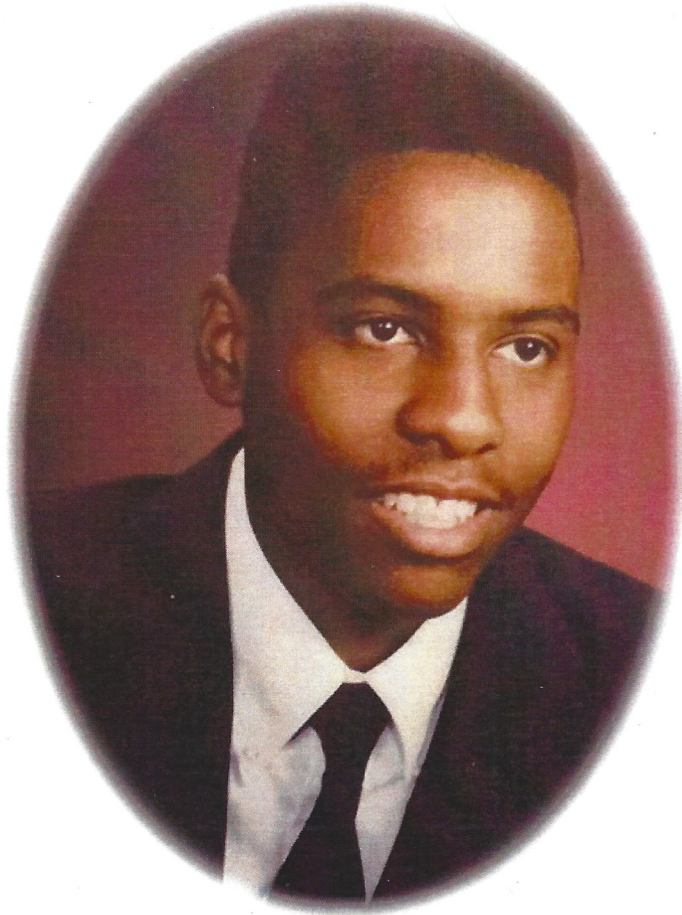

seeing the world.

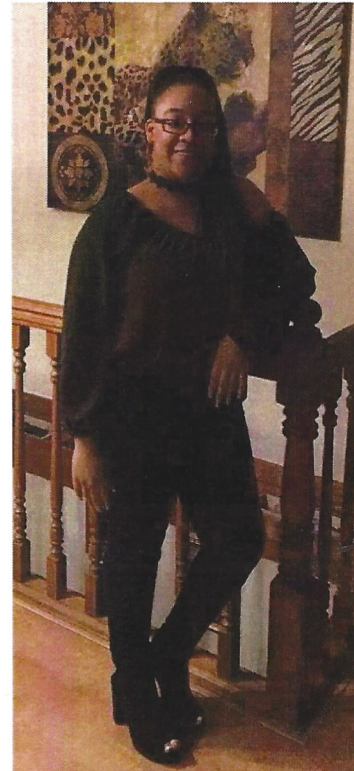
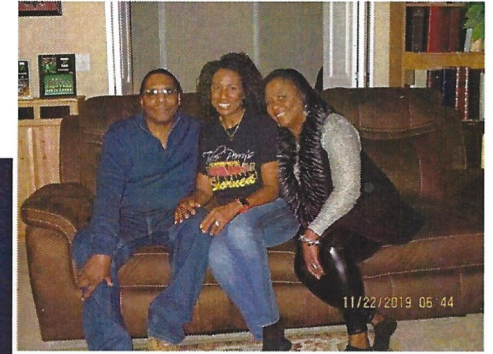
James leaves to cherish precious memories, his mother

Philadelphia.

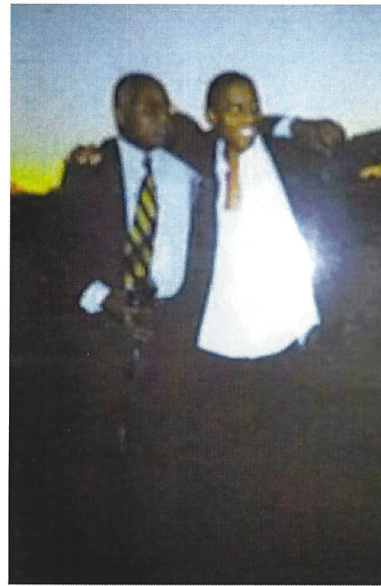
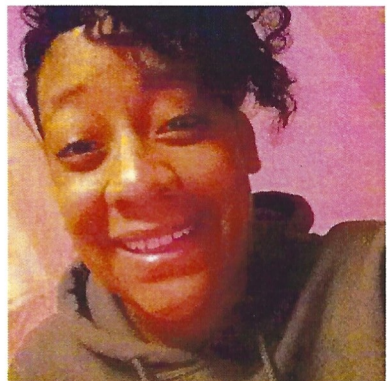
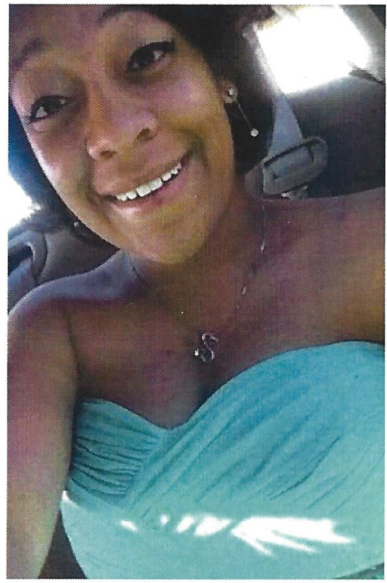
